# YMCA PRESCHOOL

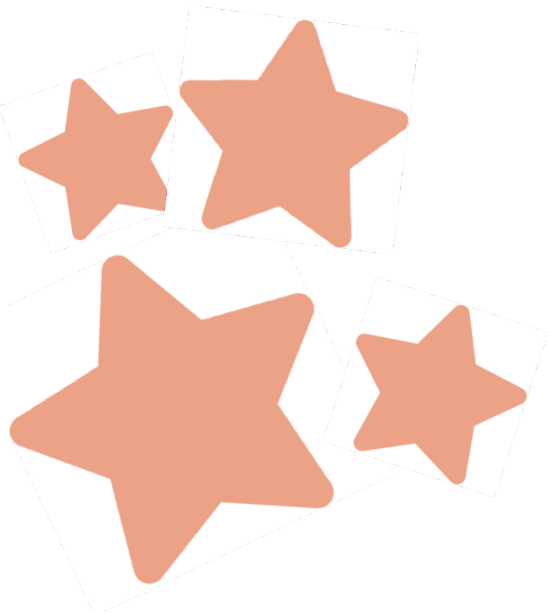
Our goal is to provide a safe, stimulating and fun environment for children to learn through participation. We incorporate the Y's core values: Honesty, Responsibility, Respect and Caring in our activities.

The Upper Palmetto YMCA is committed to providing the highest quality Preschool possible. We are excited about the unique programming opportunities provided by our Preschool program. We strive to develop the whole child through programs that build a healthy spirit, mind and body for all, including the following:

**Healthy Spirit** - We offer daily devotion time, and a group discussion time, where the children have the opportunity to reflect on their day, and talk about issues and concerns impacting their lives. Children also develop a stronger understanding of the core YMCA values of Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, and Caring.

**Healthy Mind** - Our staff works diligently to develop and implement hands-on, inquiry based educational programs to meet the needs of our preschool children.

**Healthy Body** - In an effort to promote healthy living, the YMCA provides daily fitness time. Activities may include indoor water play and outdoor games and activities.

## Registration Information

**MONTHLY DRAFT:** Fees are paid by credit/debit card drafts on the first of each month. A \$20 late fee will be enforced for payments not received within three days of automatic credit card or bank draft decline due to lack of funds or any other card issue by the card holder. If tuition becomes delinquent for more than three days, children may not be allowed to attend the preschool program until full payment has been satisfied or payment arrangements have been made.

**REGISTRATION FEE:** Participants are required to pay a \$125 nonrefundable registration fee per child.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:** A limited amount of financial assistance is available. Please complete the application available at the YMCA front desk or visit [www.ymcaup.org](http://www.ymcaup.org) to download an application. Allow 4-6 weeks for processing prior to the first day of enrollment. Preschool Assistance is awarded for the school year 2021/2022.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER:** When faced with potentially dangerous weather conditions, the YMCA Preschool will follow the Fort Mill School District's decision on closings. Information can be found at their website [www.fort-mill.k12.sc.us](http://www.fort-mill.k12.sc.us) and on the local news. Information is also relayed by the primary radio and television stations in Rock Hill and Charlotte. If there is a FMSD school delay, the Preschool will close for the day. Should inclement weather occur after preschool begins, we encourage parents to pick up their child as soon as possible.
