Corporate Confession of Sin

Eternal God, you have rescued us from deep darkness and brought us into your glorious light. We were trapped in spiritual blindness and spiritual death. But now, because your son has been born and given to us, we have eternal joy, peace, and security.

Right now and forever you reign in glory, majesty, compassion, power, and justice. All kings, rulers, governments, and powers are pawns in your omnipotent hands. Yet, we refuse to believe that you are the eternal King, almighty God, tender Shepherd, and good Father.

We stress over world events. We fret over our circumstances. We are afraid. We fail to abide in the shalom you provide, and we fail to live at peace with one another.

Forgive us for our unbelief. Forgive us for our worry. Forgive us for our attempts to control. Forgive us for our small view of you. Forgive us for our misplaced trust in gods who cannot save or provide.

Cause us to rejoice in the salvation that is ours in Jesus Christ, God with us. Give us the gift of faith, and cause us to rest in your great power, goodness, wisdom, and grace. Amen.

This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

Having confessed our sins, the minister declares a gospel promise assuring that God forgives us because Christ has fully atoned for all the sins of those who truly repent. Divine mercy frees us from our guilt and shame.
