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The Basics

Our course is compatible with both PC and Mac devices, and basic computer knowledge is required. You will need the following:

- Microsoft Office with Excel, PowerPoint and Word (or similar software)
- Internet access

Software Required: Making this course cost-effective: An alternative to purchasing Microsoft software could be using Google Workspace. It automatically saves data and does not take up space on the laptop system making it more user friendly.
