Income Statement Highlights





Revenues rose 14% y-o-y to EGP 34,546.5 million in 9M 2019. Although revenue from the core wires and cables segment fell by 3.7% y-o-y, overall top line growth was driven by turnkey projects, which grew by 55.7% y-o-y.



 Gross Profit saw a 2.2% y-o-y increase to EGP 5,297.3 million in 9M 2019. The company's gross profit margin normalized from 17.1% in 9M 2018 to 15.3% in 9M 2019.

EBITDA (EGP bn)



• EBITDA posted a 5.6% y-o-y decrease to EGP 4,081.5 million in 9M 2019, yielding an EBITDA margin of 11.8% compared to 14.3% in 9M 2018.

Net Income (after Minority Interest) (EGP bn)



• Net Income after Minority Interest recorded EGP 2,717.2 million in 9M 2019 compared to EGP 3,503.5 million posted in the same period last year, representing a 22.4% decline y-o-y. Meanwhile, the net profit margin stood at 7.9% in 9M 2019 versus 11.6% in 9M 2018.

• Despite a significant growth revenue over the last 4 years, Elsewedy has maintained a relatively low CAPEX to sales (less than 4% between 2014 and 2018)



• Dividends per share for 2018 was EGP 0.80/share and is testament to the commitment of Elsewedy's board to the continued provision of dividends, despite normalized growth for the year



Net Debt Ratios



 Net debt to EBITDA decreased substantially over the last 4 years, from 2.2x in 2014 to 0.001x in 2018, while net debt to equity also fell from 0.5x to 0.0005x, indicating a marginal level of debt in comparison to the company's size of operations

Elsewedy Technical Academy





In 2011, Elsewedy Electric established the Elsewedy Electric Technical School which aims to support technical school graduates and prepare them to join the workforce. The school teaches them how to get acquainted with relevant education pathways for those who want to continue beyond upper secondary education. STA launched its first academy in September

2016 which hosted 600 students. It plans to acquire the Quality Management Certificate ISO 29990 in 2018

Students join STA on full scholarships, providing them with uniforms, learning material, electronic learning devices, transportation and on-the-job training during their three year course of study, in addition to financial support in the form of monthly compensation.
