

Wordpress plugin uses authentication to communicate with an api, powered by the stand alone application.

There is an html template file, and style sheet included in the /template/ folder, which you can edit MANUALLY to change the look and feel of the generated testimonial.

Testimonials will be displayed by using a short tag ...

```
[review id=x]
```

Placed anywhere on a wordpress page.

There are 3 additional options, which can be added to the short tag to do certain things.

```
[review id=7 website=no audio=no]
```

That will be used to NOT include the users website into the testimonial card, if one is provided.

Same with the audio=no option.

ALSO, you can auto play the audio, by using

```
[review id=1 audio=autoplay]
```
