Sullivan's Cove - Hobart's birthplace and ferry terminal Parliament House Salamanca Place - Georgian style warehouses now restored as restaurants, galleries and pubs St. David's Park South Hobart at the foot of Mt. Wellington St. David's Cathedral Treasury Building and Franklin Square GPO and Hobart Town Hall Penitentiary Chapel Queen's Domain and Government House Victoria Dock and Constitution Dock Enjoy some free time to see the exquisite Royal Tasmanian Botanical Gardens (optional)

Richmond

Head out the Brooker Highway passing North Hobart and New Town Derwent Entertainment Centre Richmond – one of Australia's most unique and historic towns dating from the 1820s

Stroll across the Richmond Bridge – Introduce yourself to the local ducks, as they forage for good under the oldest convict-built road bridge in Australia Also set in this idyllic location is the oldest operating Catholic Church Perhaps visit Richmond Gaol – operational from 1826

Taste some Coal Valley region wines and local produce (own expense), shop or just relax.

Whatever you choose there's plenty of time to explore the village, it's quaint cottages, unique shops, galleries and restaurants.

DAY 6: TOUR OF PORT ARTHUR.

See the Penitentiary – a onetime granary and flour mill, separate prison,
Commandant's House, church and more Enjoy a cruise on Carnarvon Bay around the Isle of the Dead, then back to the Historic Site for free time to purchase your own lunch and explore at your own pace

DAY 7: TOUR OF RUSSEL FALLS & BONORONG WILDLIFE.

Arriving at **Mt Field National Park** start with an easy walk through a canopy of rainforest and fern glades to view crystal clear waters and the spectacle of Russell Falls. Soak up the serenity and atmosphere of majestic tall tree ferns providing a canopy for a delightful walk alongside a forest stream.

Lunch (at your own expense) can be enjoyed in the park.

There may be an opportunity to purchase fresh raspberries from roadside stalls (seasonal)

Arriving at Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary, get ready for your up-close encounter with the iconic Tasmanian Devil and other native animals. This is an amazing opportunity to learn more about our unique wildlife and perhaps hand feed the animals that roam free.
