DAY 4: GOLD COAST HIGHLIGHTS.

Breakfast at the hotel restaurant. We continue to explore Gold Coast on another full day attractions visits.

Burleigh Heads sits like a cool comma between Surfers Paradise to the north and Coolangatta to the south. It's a picturesque punctuation mark along the Gold Coast and most definitely

somewhere to pause. Locals and visitors alike flock here for world-class point break, unbeatable beaches, lively cafe and dining scene, nature walks and the all-around sunny vibes that this beloved location has to offer. The National Park that occupies most of the headland provides bush walks through lush rainforest and breathtaking views of the Gold Coast. Shaded by pine trees and pandanus palms, the elevated grassy park on Goodwin Terrace known as "The Point" is a popular spot for sunsets, picnics and gatherings. The beaches here are lined with beautiful parkland, scattered with BBQs, playgrounds and facilities for all to enjoy Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary on the Gold Coast has long been one of the most popular attractions in south-east Queensland, and it isn't hard to see why. Get up close with a ton of the best and cutest native Aussie and exotic wildlife at the many interactive displays and wide-open enclosures, while walking amongst the lush, comfortable eucalyptus and rainforest environments. All your animal favourites are here; you can cuddle up to and have your photo taken with a koala, get up close with crocodiles, hand-feed the many friendly kangaroos and much, much more.

Be sure to stay around for the Rainbow Lorikeet feeding - one of the main attractions - with two demonstrations, morning from 8am and afternoon from 4pm.

Elephant Rock is a well-known rock formation located on Currumbin Beach and is the remains of ancient volcanic activity. Beach goers can climb the stairs to a platform at the top of the rock for views of Surfers Paradise and Coolangatta. Elephant Rock has become a major and significant site for the annual Anzac Day Dawn Service and houses a war memorial plaque at the western base of the rock.

5 Minutes Helicopter Ride
Tour 1 takes off from Sea World Helicopter's terminal and climbs over the Broadwater. As your helicopter crosses the coast you will experience unforgettable views of the city's towering high-rises including Gold Coast's internationally recognised landmark, the Q1 Building. You will then journey north along the coastline and fly over Porpoise Point before banking left at South Stradbroke Island. On the return run to the terminal, you will fly down the Broadwater and have breathtaking views of the city skyline and the rolling hinterland.

Sea World is a unique opportunity for everyone to see incredible marine animals up close. Learn all about the Polar Bears, Penguins, Sharks, Seals and the Dolphins here. Presentations are held here throughout the day so you can see the animals being fed and learn more

about their species. The Dolphin Presentation is a favourite and should not be missed. The Jet Stunt Extreme is also a highlight. Sea World also has kids entertainment. Meet the Nickelodeon characters or take a ride on some of the family friendly coasters including Stormcoaster and Jet Rescue.
