

6 DAYS SYDNEY HIGHLIGHTS



DAY-01: WELCOME TO SYDNEY.

Arrive at Sydney International Airport. Welcome to Sydney, Australia! Your airport private coach transfer will take you to your hotel in Sydney.

Check in to hotel. The rest of today is free at your own leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY-02: SYDNEY CITY TOUR & HARBOUR LUNCHEON CRUISE.

After breakfast from your hotel, enjoy your full Sydney City Tour & Harbour Luncheon Cruise.

Note: Please make your way from your hotel to pick up/drop off point and to Skyfeast Restaurant in Sydney Eye Tower and back to hotel.

Depart your hotel for an unforgettable Panoramic Sydney half day city sights tour. On tour you will visit the historic Rocks area and hear of early convict history. We continue through the financially focused Central Business District (CBD), and Macquarie Street. Marvel at 18th century sandstone architecture such as NSW Parliament House, Rum Hospital, Hyde Park Barracks and St Mary's Cathedral.

We will continue to Mrs Macquaries Point, to enjoy magnificent views of the Sydney Opera House and Harbour Bridge.

We then continue through Sydney's Eastern Suburbs, home to the rich and famous. Travelling along the coves and shores of one of the world's most impressive harbours, we will take a few stops for photo opportunities, including a panoramic photo of Sydney skyline. You will pass through areas such as Kings Cross, Double Bay, Rose Bay before arriving at Watsons Bay, passengers will have the option a short coastal walk with views of the South Pacific Ocean and the entrance to Sydney harbor.

Travel on to famous Bondi Beach for a 30-minute stop. Visit the beachfront promenade, put your toes in the sand, enjoy a coffee or cool drink (at own cost). See bronzed Aussie lifesavers and surfers riding the waves of Bondi.

Re-board your bus and continue on to Tamarama and Bronte beaches before returning to the city via Centennial Park and Paddington, a trendy district with its elegant terrace houses and boutique shops along Oxford Street.

Arrive at Circular Quay for your Sydney Harbour lunch cruise. Departing from the Eastern Pontoon at 12noon you will spend 2 relaxing hours discovering the secrets of one of the world's most famous and spectacular natural harbours including icons such as Sydney Harbour Bridge, the Opera House, Sydney Botanical Gardens and more. We give you a chance to see the city from a new perspective and marvel at the sights that decorate its coastline. You will get to learn something new about Sydney, its history and about each of the sights that you can see from the deck. Your cruise concludes at 2.15pm at Circular quay and on arrival, make your way at leisure back to your hotel. Your cruise includes a full buffet lunch with a mix of hot and cold selections, and fresh seafood, as well as a beverage package.

In the late afternoon, proceed to Sydney Tower for your buffet dinner at the Skyfeast revolving restaurant. A superb 360-degree panoramic views of Sydney City. After your dinner, you're own way back to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Breakfast at the hotel and join in to your full day Blue Mountain Tour.

We will venture into the World Heritage listed Blue Mountains region where you will experience the raw magic the Blue Mountains has to offer, with sheer rock faces that plunge into eucalypt clad valleys, along with native flora and fauna of the Blue Mountains and spectacular waterfalls. Immerse yourself into the rich beauty the Blue Mountains has to offer.

Continuing on, drive through Katoomba towards the famous Three Sisters. Whilst the Blue Mountains features so much more than this natural attraction you can't help but admire the unquestionable beauty of this amazing rock formation. The character of the Three Sisters changes throughout the day and throughout the seasons as the sunlight brings out the magnificent colours. Here your guide will discuss the legends behind this famous rock formation and time available for you to take some great photos.

We then make our way visiting Scenic World to enjoy the three rides, Skyway, Cableway and Railway as well as a walk through the rainforest. You will have the opportunity to walk through the ancient rainforest, with beautiful fern trees and viewing on the Blue Mountains. See spectacular views of the Three Sisters and vast expanse of the Jamison valley.

Lunch is own arrangement.

After lunch, we will head down the mountain to Sydney Zoo, the ultimate Australian wildlife experience. You will see kangaroos, koalas, wallabies, crocodiles, wombats, and Tasmanian devils. From Sydney Zoo, we will pass by Sydney Olympic Park and we will drop off guests at the ferry where tour will conclude at Circular Quay approximately 4.30 - 5.00pm. DAY-04: CANBERRA AUSTRALIA'S CAPITAL TOUR (WED/SAT only) or HUNTER VALLEY WINE, CHEESE & CHOCOLATE TOUR.

Breakfast at the hotel. Experience the Canberra – Australia's capital city of a full day Canberra Tour.

Note: Please make your way from your hotel to pick up/drop off point.

Your awesome driver guide will pick you up early morning, and soon you'll be enroute to our Bush Capital, cruising the NSW Southern Highlands through typical small Australian country towns. We'll stop somewhere along the way so you can grab a coffee (*own expense*) and stretch your legs before arriving at Canberra.

We take a guided tour at **Canberra Parliament House**, an architectural masterpiece costing \$1.1 billion. From the inner walls of power to walking on the roof, this is an amazing spot to explore.

We then take a break for lunch (*own expense*) before we spend two hours of free time at the **National Museum of Australia**. The modern National Museum of Australia is well-known for controversial expositions regarding key issues of Australia's social history, people and events.

After your free time here, you'll rejoin the group for a visit of **the Australian War Memorial**. Reflect as you learn about the legends of Gallipoli, the ANZACs and sacrifices and losses suffered by Australians in past wars fought around the world.

We then take a drive through Yarralumla, one of Canberra's largest suburbs, for a close look of the many national embassies. Each embassy is uniquely designed to reflect aspects of their country's culture.

OR

The Hunter Valley Tour. Travelling in a small group, this tour exposes you to the magnificent selection of wines that characterizes the region. Throughout the day, you'll get to explore the sprawling landscape of the Valley and learn more about the unique processes and terroir that make the area's best-loved produce. We'll take you to taste local cheeses, chocolates, spirits and to visit cellar doors for the ultimate Hunter Valley Day out.

We'll visit the premium Hunter Valley wineries to sample their locally produced vinos. Sip your way through the spectrum of whites and reds as a wine expert guides you through the various styles

found in the Hunter Valley. To complement the top-notch drops, enjoy a chocolate and cheese tastings paired with a selection of wines. If you taste something you like, pick up a few bottles to drink back home or to share with friends.

For lunch, we'll enjoy a delicious restaurant 1 course lunch that makes use of the Hunter Valley's fresh local produce. Enjoy a glass of wine, beer or cider with your meal to top it off. If you fancy something a little stronger, the Hunter Valley Distillery will be right up your alley. Taste their unique flavours of vodka, gin and liqueur including black tea liqueur, chilli schnapps and more. All served in test tubes, these colourful and flavoursome spirits are always a hit!

In the afternoon, we'll make our way back to the bright lights of Sydney where the tour unfortunately ends.
