Extractive Industries

Kazakhstan has the largest recoverable [crude oil](#) reserves in the Caspian Sea region. The hydrocarbon industry is estimated to account for roughly 50% of the government's revenues. Kazakhstan's proven oil reserves are estimated at 30 billion barrels. Current oil production, approximately 1.7 million barrels/day, is dominated by two giant fields: Tengiz and Karachaganak, which produce about half of Kazakhstan's total output. Proven natural gas reserves are estimated at 1.3 trillion cubic feet (Tcf) ([Source: BP Statistical Review of Energy 2014](#)).

Kazakhstan produces 36% of the world's uranium and has extensive mineral resources such as chromium, copper, gold, iron, lead, manganese, and zinc ([USGS Minerals Yearbook Kazakhstan](#)).

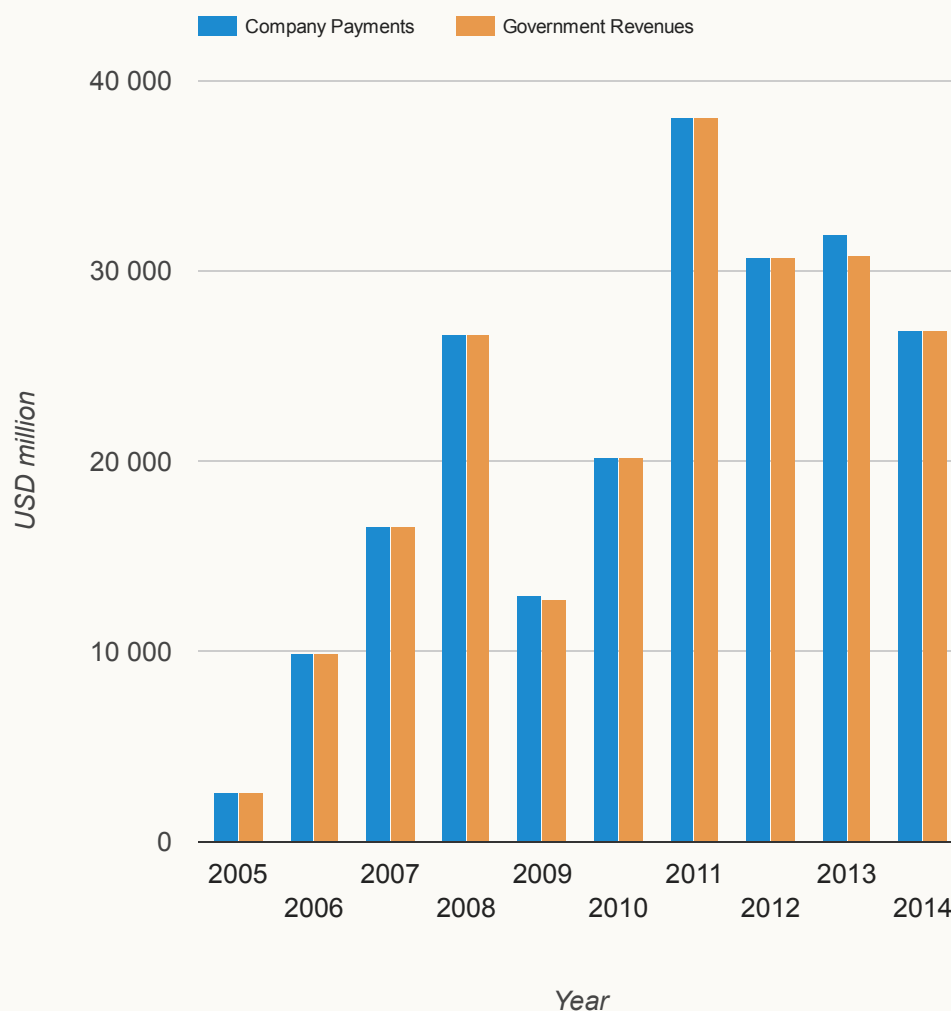

Having achieved compliance in [October 2013](#), the National Stakeholder Council is now undertaking a review process with a view to identify new activities for EITI implementation. The consultation process will feed in to a revised [workplan](#)[?]. There is considerable interest among stakeholders to decentralise the EITI process and establish regional multi-stakeholder forums, in particular in resource-rich provinces. 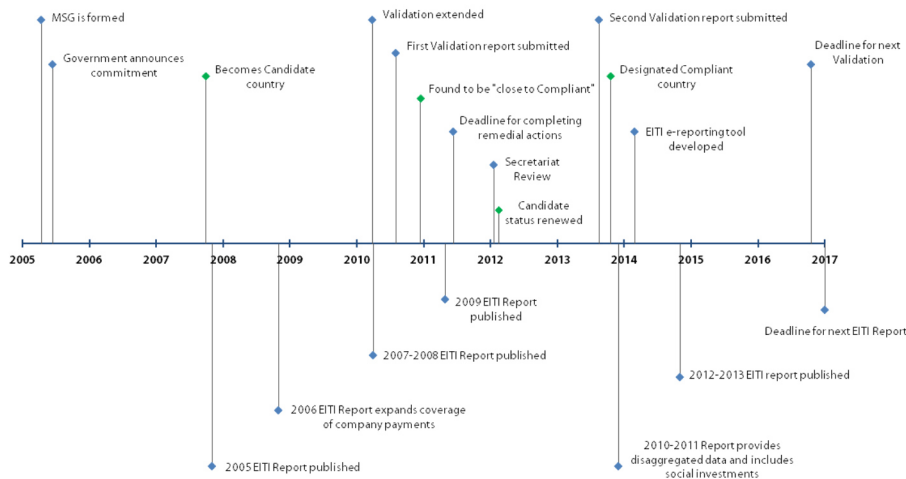
