His Excellency the President of the Republic of Zimbabwe has approved the granting of 12 Licenses on 13 March 2014.

The granting of the 12 exploration licenses by His Excellency the President comprising is a milestone in the recent history of the Mining Industry in this country considering that Prospecting Orders were granted in 2002, 12 years ago.

This signifies a serious shift in policy and heralds a new chapter that should see the mini the economic revival of the country as envisaged by the ZimAsset
