MUSCAT: Oman government on Thursday signed an oil concession agreement with Hydrocarbon Finder to take over an existing block on production sharing basis.

under this agreement include reinterpretation of the existing data, acquire 3D seismic surveys, conducts studies, provide operational support and drilling of several development and exploration wells.
