



Visualizations

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Qatar is the 35th largest export economy in the world and the 60th most complex economy according to the Economic Complexity Index (ECI). In 2014, Qatar exported \$125B and imported \$32.8B, resulting in a positive trade balance of \$92.4B. In 2014 the GDP of Qatar was \$210B and its GDP per capita was \$140k.

The top exports of Qatar are Petroleum Gas (\$72.2B), Crude Petroleum (\$34.3B), Refined Petroleum (\$10.1B), Ethylene Polymers (\$2.65B) and Nitrogenous Fertilizers (\$1.33B), using the 1992 revision of the HS (Harmonized System) classification. Its top imports are Cars (\$2.72B), Planes, Helicopters, and/or Spacecraft (\$2.06B), Aircraft Parts (\$991M), Gas Turbines (\$982M) and Special Purpose Ships (\$910M).

The top export destinations of Qatar are Japan (\$32B), South Korea (\$24.5B), India (\$16.5B), Singapore (\$9.8B) and China (\$8.87B). The top import origins are China (\$2.98B), the United States (\$2.9B), Germany (\$2.78B), the United Kingdom (\$2.51B) and the United Arab Emirates (\$2.42B).

Qatar borders Saudi Arabia by land and the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain and Iran by sea.

Exports

In 2014 Qatar exported \$125B, making it the 35th largest exporter in the world. During the last five years the exports of Qatar have increased at an annualized rate of 22.5%, from \$45.3B in 2009 to \$125B in 2014. The most recent exports are led by **Petroleum Gas** which represent 57.7% of the total exports of Qatar, followed by **Crude Petroleum**, which account for 27.4%.

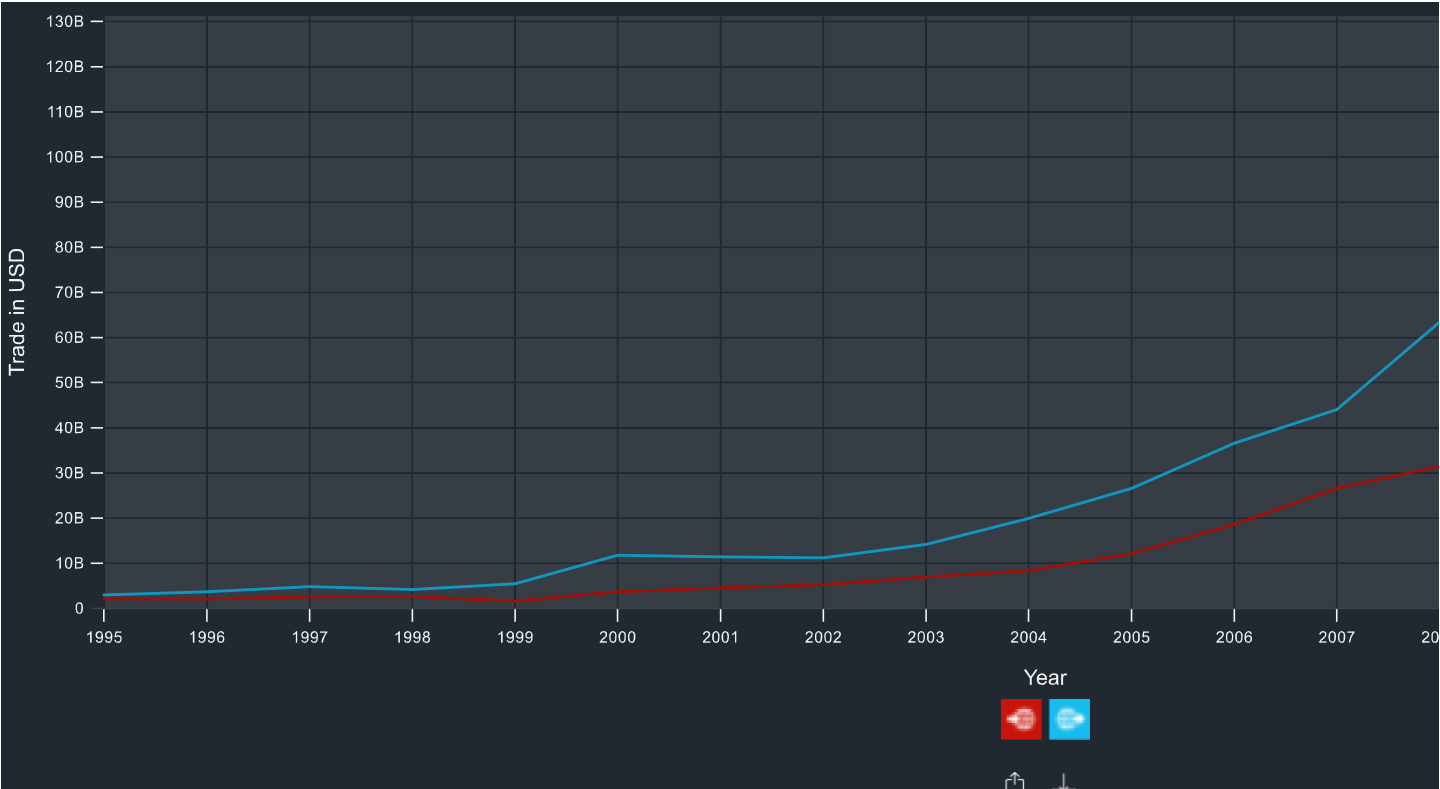

ECONOMIC COMPLEXITY OF QATAR

Product Space

The product space is a network connecting products that are likely to be co-exported and can be used to predict the evolution of a country's export structure.

The economy of Qatar has an Economic Complexity Index (ECI) of 0.236 making it the 60th most complex country. Qatar exports 22 products with revealed comparative advantage (meaning that its share of global exports is larger than what would be expected from the size of its export economy and from the size of a product's global market).
