What We Do

Diamond Mining

ZMDC owns 100% shareholding in Marange Resources which is engaged in diamond mining in Chiadzwa, Mutare in the eastern part of Zimbabwe. Since 2005 ZMDC has entered into Joint Venture agreements with international companies to form: Anjin Investment, Diamond Mining Corporation, Jinan Mining, RERA, Gye Nyame, Kusena Diamonds and Mbada Resources. Diamond mining has contributed significantly to the foreign currency earnings of the country.

Gold Mining

Sabi Gold Mine in Zvishavane, Jena Gold Mines in Silobela and Elvington Gold Mine in Chegutu have a significant contribution to Zimbabwe's gold production as well as increasing foreign exchange earnings for the country.

Platinum

The Corporation holds approximately 26 000 hectares of platinum claims in the Hartley and Shurugwi su-chambers of the Great Dyke. The Corporation entered into joint venture agreements with international companies for exploration and resource estimations.

Graphite

ZMDC holds a Joint Venture with Graphitwerk Kropffmuhs to form Zimbabwe German Graphite Mine (ZGGM) (Pvt) Ltd which mines graphite in Karoi.

Emerald

Zimbabwe's Sandawana mines have been an important producer of emeralds for 40 years. Consistent production has been established and in addition to the small sizes Sandawana emeralds is known for greater numbers of polished stones that have been produced.
