Due to the particularity of complicate the world mining industry has developed many initiatives to support the work of management. In particular, the initiative of transparency in mining industries (EITI) was considered one of the most effective management initiative. According to reviews, Nigieria has avoided lost 1 billion u.s. dollars annually in the mining sector thanks to the implementation of this initiative. In addition, EITI supports reform of the mining sector in many countries, such as are found in the Philippines.

Vietnam has started approaching the EITI in 2005. However, after almost 10 years of review, Vietnam has yet to produce a clear statement about the EITI participation despite the reforms demand for today's mining industry. Focal agencies consider that the EITI implementation should continue to consider the issues related to the statistical system and the capability of business reporting.


