The main purpose of this Non-Technical Summary (NTS) is to facilitate communication and public involvement, as public participation is a pillar of modern approaches to impact assessment, in a fully transparent perspective. The NTS presents, in non-technical language, the findings of a detailed Environmental, Social and Health Impact Assessment (ESHIA) undertaken in connection with the Offshore Cape Three Points (OCTP) project in Ghana and is a tool that allows consultation of stakeholders and their participation into the EIA process. Moreover ESHIA disclosure is a requirement set by

Ghanaian Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The NTS provides an integrated overview of the two phases of the OCTP Development related to the oil exploitation - Phase 1 and gas exploitation - Phase 2, in order to make stakeholders aware the of the project activities and their consequences on environment, socio-economic and health components.. The multiple, and sometimes conflicting uses of marine ecosystems require the organization of marine space to manage interactions between users and to ensure that demands for development are balanced in relation to the need to protect the marine environment. Amlalo at the commissioning of the EPA Head Office Environmental Quality Laboratory.He said The EPA is mandated by the EPA Act 1994(Act 490) to prescribe standards and guidelines relating to the pollution of the air, water, land and noise among others. Over the years, EPA has developed sector specific environmental quality guidelines for reducing emissions and discharge of toxic wastes and substances into the environment.He said, in as much as the sector specific guidelines have been useful, the Agency in collaboration with the Ghana Standards Authority and the Attorney Generals department is working to transform these guidelines into standards.
