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Payment of Service Levies by GGM and NMGM at 0.3%

The Ministry of Energy and Minerals (MEM) would like to inform the general public that Geita gold Mine owned by M/s AngloGold Ashanti; and Bulyanhulu, Buzwagi and North Mara Gold Mines owned by M/s Acacia Mining have started paying service levies at the rate of 0.3 percent (0.3%) of the annual turnover to relevant districts as per Local Government Finance Act, Cap. 290, Revised Editions of 2002; instead of the cap limit payment of US\$ 200,000 per annum stipulated in the Mining Development Agreement (MDAs).

The beneficiaries of this service levy include Geita Town Council; Geita District Council; Msalala District Council; Kahama Town Council; and Tarime District Council. The effective date is 1st July, 2014.

This follows after agreed addendum to make amendments of all MDAs between the Government and AngloGold Ashanti which owns Geita Gold Mine on one hand and Acacia Mining which owns Bulyanhulu, Buzwagi and North Mara Gold Mines on the other hand.
