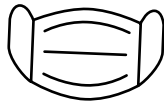


# COVID-19 LEARN TO SKATE PRIVATE LESSON PROTOCOLS

A combination of measures developed by the British Columbian Recreation and Parks Association and approved by the Provincial Health Authority have been implemented to prevent the transmission of COVID-19. As per the Oval's Policies, we will adhere to the following principles for Learn to Skate private lessons:

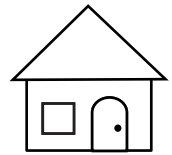


## PERSONAL HYGIENE



- » Staff to wear non-medical mask and gloves
- » Participants may choose to wear masks
- » Limiting the number of people on the ice to spread out and maintain distance between lessons

## STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK



- » Routine daily screening for all staff
- » Participants and staff must not attend program if they are symptomatic or feeling unwell
- » Isolation rooms will be provided to anyone who becomes sick while at the Oval

## SAFE SOCIAL INTERACTIONS



- » To minimize gatherings, we will be offering only a limited selection of private lessons and semi-private lessons (max of 4 participants)
- » Maintain 6ft/2M physical distance when possible
- » We are encouraging only one guardian be present at the rink per participant to maintain maximum social distancing measures

## INCREASED CLEANING AND SANITIZATION



- » Increased frequency of deep cleaning and sanitization by staff
- » Ice clean every hour
- » Skate and helmet rentals will be available but you must request them at the time of booking
- » Rentals will be sanitized and rotated out of circulation for three days after use
