Dr. Jamonica Rolle is a distinguished academic leader with over 20 years of experience in teaching and administration. She currently serves as College Provost and Senior Vice President of Academic Affairs and College Operations at Broward College, a role she has held since July 2024. In this role, she serves as the Chief Academic Officer, leading the strategic direction, operation, and evaluation of academic affairs. She is accountable for academic success and overall experience of 52,000 students and 1,100 faculty members. Throughout her tenure, Dr. Rolle has held key leadership roles including Vice Provost of Academic Affairs and North Campus, Dean of Academic Affairs and Associate Dean of Communication & Fine Arts.

Before transitioning into senior leadership, Dr. Rolle served as a full-time faculty member in Speech Communication at Broward College. Her teaching background also includes positions as a Graduate Business Communication Instructor at Florida Atlantic University and a high school English and Reading teacher in Broward County Public Schools.

Dr. Rolle has led major institutional initiatives focused on student success, academic excellence, and strategic partnerships. She has successfully championed innovation in teaching and learning, prioritizing the acquisition of cutting-edge tools that integrate Artificial Intelligence (AI), Extended Reality (XR), and, where applicable, advanced robotics, embedding these technologies across the curriculum. Her leadership has driven numerous student retention and post-completion initiatives, including developmental education reform, a dynamic co-curricular students and faculty engagement agenda, and strategic community and institutional partnerships. Additionally, she has been instrumental in programs designed to foster local and state economic development. As Vice President/Campus President for the North Campus, Dr. Rolle established and nurtured lasting collaborations with municipal, community, and industry leaders.

She holds a B.A. and M.A. in Communication from Florida Atlantic University and an Ed.D. in Higher Education Administration from the University of Florida. Dr. Rolle serves on the Board of Directors for 211 Broward, the Pompano Beach Economic Development Council, and a local chamber of commerce.
