# JOB SHADOW • BRANDYWINE HOSPITAL | TOWER HEALTH, CSIU, HACKENSACK AUIOLOGY AND HEARING ASSOCIATES • AUGUST-NOVEMBER 2019

I shadowed a SLP working with adults at the Brandywine Hospital. There, I witnessed an adult swallow study and a few patient's follow ups after strokes. I watched the SLP check that the patient was able to swallow foods of various thicknesses.

When I shadowed an SLP working for the Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit, I observed children ages 3 to 5 in preschool or home settings. For the majority of the sessions, I learned how to use games and snacks to teach children how to make specific sounds.

I also shadowed an audiologist in Hackensack where I witnessed a hearing test for an adult patient and a hearing aid fitting and equipment check for a child patient.
