Summary of selected projects managed.

- South-South zonal coordinator for Better Obstetrics for Rural Nigeria (BORN) study RAND cooperation USA, 2014. Reviewed and revised survey material for data collection, pilot tested the electronic data collection tool in 3 different health facilities not selected for the study. Recruited, trained and monitored 60 enumerators in 6 different states in Nigeria while conducting survey on 4,160 households. Developed a quality assurance checklist which was used in all study sites to eliminate re-visits and in-complete data throughout the study period.
 - As a co-investigator, drafted EOI for grant, designed and developed a HIV research proposal for National Agency for the Control of AIDS (NACA), a World Bank assisted study, 2013. Monitored and supervised the implementation of the study on 443 selected participants from 8 health facilities across 4 states in Nigeria and 70% efficacy was obtained from the study result informing NACA that age at first sexual contact (<19 years), marital status and blood transfusion were associated with High HIV prevalence in some states in Nigeria.
 - As a project manager for RESYST study in Lagos, Nigeria. Assisted PIs during proposal development efforts, including drafting contracts, document drafting and review. Paid advocacy visits to state commissioners, interviewed Hon. Comm. of Health, Finance, Chairman, Lagos state board of internal revenue services, Chairman House of Assembly Committee on Health using a pre-tested interviewer's guide. Transcribed all recorded interviews in Microsoft word format and prepared a report for all data collection activities done in the study as well.

- As a project manager for an ABT associate sponsored project on pro-poor health insurance, I recruited, trained and supervised 36 enumerators for qualitative and quantitative data collection on 1440 study participants selected across micro finance banks in Lagos State Nigeria. Designed and developed the quality assurance checklist that was used to ensure data collected was complete and accurate for the duration of the study, 65% efficacy was obtained from the study result and informed ABT associates on people's willingness to pay for health insurance with a complete package of health care access.
- Designed, trained and monitored enumerators on malaria control study. Designed, developed and published a paper with the study result, "**Enemuoh J, Onwujekwe O, Uzochukwu B, Oranuba J and Lilika A.** Quality of monitoring and evaluation of malaria control activities: tracking stock-outs and replenishment of supplies in Anambra State, Nigeria.
