This program is designed to assist with one minor home repair such as electrical, plumbing, heating or energy conservation upgrade. This program is intended to provide roof replacement and/ or repair needed to correct roofing, gutter and fascia problems. Garages are not included unless attached to the home.

This program assists with specific home repairs to eliminate conditions immediately detrimental to the health and safety of human life.

The City of Canton Department of Development is now accepting applications for the 2019 Home Repair Programs. These programs are available to low-income individuals who own a home in the City of Canton. Program facts and eligibility guidelines can be found on our website.

Applications will be available March 4, 2019 through April 1, 2019

The City has established a priority rating system combined with staggered review and award periods to allow us to meet demand in an equitable fashion. Our priority rating system assigns points to each application which is then ranked based on factors such as income, household size, elderly, disabled, and housing condition. This is to assure that resources are going to the highest priority cases since demand typically exceeds resources.
