This course allowed me to gain knowledge of pre-hospital skills to deescalate medical emergencies. I held a lifeguard certification for seven years, which gave me water safety and CPR knowledge.

In August of 2019, I completed a Field Training Exercise, NY Hope, at the NY State Preparedness Training Center in Oriskany, NY. This training program is a domestic disaster response exercise that challenges participants to overcome their fears and hone their skills as emergency responders. It is a four-day full immersion disaster simulation exercise. I worked together in teams, rotated leadership positions, while being immersed in mass casualty situations, water rescue operations, secondary triage and treatment, damage assessment and emergency (IC/EOC/Cyber) operations.
