- FFA Proficiency Award in Veterinary Science is awarded to members of the FFA organization in the category of Entrepreneurship/Placement in Veterinary Science where they work for a business that includes working with veterinarians in clinical practice, research facilities, colleges of veterinary medicine, animal health industry, or any other environment in which they assist veterinarians in performing duties related to the health of people and/or the health and welfare of large and small animals.
- FFA Proficiency Award in Agriculture Science Research is awarded to FFA members in the category of Agriscience Research-Animal Systems where members research in the life processes, health, nutrition, genetics, management, and processing of animal systems related to small animals, aquaculture, livestock, dairy, horses and/or poultry.
- American FFA Degree is the highest degree that an FFA member can get. This degree shows an FFA member's dedication to his or her chapter and state FFA association. It demonstrates the effort FFA members apply toward their supervised agricultural experience and the outstanding leadership abilities and community involvement they exhibited through their FFA career.
- The Town of Denton Maryland Proclamation was awarded to members of the St. Luke's United Methodist Church for constructing blessing boxes that are stocked with non-perishable food items, basic toiletries, baby supplies, and anything else that might be considered a "blessing" to someone who finds themselves in need. Items are anonymously donated and anonymously received.
