2.0 Logo Standards


2.1 Logo Specifications



The Infinity Renewable Logos, in any and all forms, are integral to the face of the company; they will rarely, if ever, be absent from official IRE documents.

Please refrain from distorting the designs, changing the colors, or adding special effects. All logos are to be used on a white background.

2.2 Logo Structures



The minimum size for the lettermark logo is 0.3" high. The minimum size for the symbol logo is 0.6" high. The minimum size for the wordmark logo is 0.4" high. The minimum size for the combination logo is 1.0" high.




All business cards must be comprised of 3.5" x 2" white cardstock, utilising Microsoft Tai Le font in black for all added text. Text and logos will remain centered.

3.2 Stationary Specifications (cont.)




All envelopes are to be sized 9.5" x 4" on white paper. All text is in Microsoft Tai Le in black. Further specifications are above.







The IRE website must always reflect our desire to not only create the most eco-friendly products in our time, but continue to change and grow as the field of alternate energy grows.

The News and Our Products pages are designed with the combination logo in mind. When the combination logo is clicked, viewers will be taken back to the homepage. Please refrain from using any other logo.











5.2 Rollouts

What We Do




A closeup of a rollout menu on the homepage. Notice the white interior and rounded edges.

6.0 Miscellaneous Applications

6.1 Uniforms

Company uniforms must always ensure consistent company identification in every manner. As such, each uniform will have the symbol logo emblazoned in the top left area of the uniform. No other logos may be used.



6.2 Transportation



Due to the shape of the IRE cars' doors, the combination logo is best suited for IRE transportation designs. Please refrain from using any other type of logo.

In turn, as all logos must only be used on a white background, all IRE transportation must be painted white.
