PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DAN CARTER • William Paterson University
Senior • Designated Hitter • Bloomfield, NJ/Bloomfield

Carter collects the first NJAC Player of the Week honor of the 2022 season after starting off strong in William Paterson's season-opening win over Stevens. He went 2-for-3 with four RBI and a 2.333 slugging percentage as he hit both a home run and a triple. He blasted a three-run homer to cap off the Pioneers' six-run bottom of the third to put them up 9-0. In the fourth, he tripled down the left field line to drive in Dylan Habeeb to make it 11-0 Pioneers in the eventual 12-2 win.



PITCHER OF THE WEEK

RILEY WEIS • William Paterson University
Senior • RHP • River Vale, NJ/Pascack Valley Regional

Weis is named the first NJAC Pitcher of the Week of the 2022 season after tossing five innings of one-hit ball in William Paterson's 12-2 win over Stevens in the season opener. He was credited with the win, allowing just one hit and one run over five innings while striking out six.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

KYLE ADORNO ● Kean University

Freshman ● Centerfield ● Clark, NJ/Arthur L. Johnson

Adorno earns the first NJAC Rookie of the Week award of the 2022 season after leading Kean in its first five games, all wins. He started every game, and from the leadoff spot has scored seven runs, drawn five walks, and stolen three bases. He went 6-for-19 (.316), registering at least one hit in each game. His best so far was 2-for-4 outing against Drew in which he doubled and tripled.



ROOKIE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

NICOLAS CURCIO • Montclair State University
Freshman • Pitcher • Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown

Curcio earns the first NJAC Rookie Pitcher of the Week honor of the 2022 season after picking up a win in his collegiate debut against McDaniel. He tossed 3.0 innings in relief, allowing two hits and one run while striking out four in the eventual 6-3 win.
