PLAYER OF THE WEEK

PETER COSENTINO • Montclair State University
Senior • First Base • Flemington, NJ/Hunterdon Central

Cosentino collects his first NJAC Player of the Week honor of the 2022 season after a hot bat led Montclair State to a 3-0 week. He went 7-for-12 (.583) with 13 RBI, four doubles, two home runs, and six runs scored, recording a slugging percentage of 1.417. He went 3-for-6 with three doubles and six RBI in a 17-2 win over Bridgewater State. In a doubleheader sweep of Eastern Nazarene, he went 2-for-2, driving in four runs with two home run blasts in the 9-8 win in the opener. He followed up with a 2-for-4 outing wiht three more RBI and a double in the nightcap win over Eastern Nazarene.



PITCHER OF THE WEEK

MIKE SCHIATTARELLA • Stockton University
Junior • Pitcher • Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional

Schiattarella earns his first NJAC Pitcher of the Week honor after an historic performance. He tossed a perfect game against Western New England on Sunday. He struck out 14 hitters, including the first 8 batters of the game. It was also his second shutout of the season and the perfect game was the first in Stockton history and just the 24th all-time in NCAA Division III history. For the season he has 38 K's in 20.0 IP, with 3 complete games and a 0.90 ERA.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

MATT KALISKE • New Jersey City University
Freshman • First Base • Forked River, NJ/Lacey Twp.

Kaliske earns NJAC Rookie of the Week honors after leading NJCU to a 2-1 record last week in Florida. The rookie first baseman batted .538 with a 1.109 OPS and added team highs in hits (7), RBI (6), total bases (7) and putouts (24). He also posted a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage while starting all three games. Kaliske went 4-for-5 with a whopping five RBI, scored three runs, drew a walk and stole a base on his only attempt in a 19-9 win over Ohio Northern. Then, in Wednesday's 12-6 romp over UMass-Dartmouth, Kaliske was 3-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored.
