Step 1 (Transfer Students and Returning Students):

Step 2 (Returning Students):

Step 2 (Transfer Students):

- 1. Proof of enrollment from your new college or university
- 2. Your student ID number for this school
- 3. Your transferring school's address where the check should be mailed, so that your account is properly credited

Please note that your scholarship check will be issued and mailed to the Financial Aid Office at your new school.
