Your work will need to be prepared for exhibition at TAC. This means any two-dimensional work should be matted with either black or white mats with a sturdy back mat board. We are limited on space for unpacking artwork, so we will email your art teacher labels to print to attach to your work. These need to be attached so they hang off the right corner of the mat (please do not attach them to the top of the mat). Canvas boards and canvases do not need to be framed.

Awarded works can be dropped off at the TAC building or mailed to TAC at 3215 Cuming St. Omaha, NE 68131 on or before February 12th.

This is a remarkable achievement for you. Your work was recognized by a panel of creative professionals as the most outstanding work submitted among your peers.

Since 1923, the Awards have recognized some of America's most celebrated artists and writers while they were teenagers, including: Tschabalala Self, Stephen King, Kay WalkingStick, Charles White, Joyce Carol Oates, and Andy Warhol. We are proud to count you among these esteemed Scholastic Awards alumni!

Gold Key works have been automatically advanced to the national level of adjudication in New York City. National Medalists will be announced on Wednesday, March 23, 2022. Please log into your account at artandwriting.org that day after 12:00 pm to find out the national results.
