Job Description Summary

Job Title

The job I have chosen for the project three milestone is Community Participation Associate.

Job Roles and Responsibilities

The leading roles and responsibilities are to develop appropriate support, determined by each individual's needs, strengths, and interests. Engage with the individual to help them in the discovery process, to help them target their goals. Develop the individual for community involvement and assist with coordination and transportation (Keystone Human Services, 2022).

Prerequisites for the Job

The job posting states one must have a high school diploma or equivalent, be at least 18 years of age, and possess a valid driver's license. Applicant must have basic computer skills and knowledge of internal software programs. Practical communication skills, both verbal and written—knowledge of implementing positive change techniques and knowledge of community resources (Keystone Human Services, 2022).

Primary Industry or Type of Business

This job is listed as being in Human Services, a nonprofit organization.

Connection to Psychology

This job relates to several psychological concepts I have learned in this course, like Behavioral and socio-cultural. I see that behavior is an important concept as the teammate will champion the client's behaviors that need to be exhibited in the work environment. The socio-cultural is another essential concept as the client will interact verbally and non-verbally with people from every walk of life.

Connections to Emotional Intelligence

Self-Awareness and Self-Regulation

The job posting mentions coordination of transportation which is vital in Self-Awareness by prioritizing, organizing, and time management. With transportation especially, this aspect of the job usually has to be taken care of promptly, typically 24 hours in advance if not longer. Also, working with the developmentally challenged, you must self-regulate how you come across them and use a lower-toned, slower-paced method of communication to avoid being harsh and abrasive.

Social Awareness and Conflict Resolution

In any job, you will need to have good social awareness and conflict-resolution skills; working with people who are developmentally challenged, you have to teach them and help them to reenforce their social awareness, which would be the ability to pick up on other's emotions and to understand what is going on with them. This also ties into conflict-resolution, a situation may arise from something someone says or does, and you have to know, what to say when to say it, the tone it must be delivered in, and what action has to be taken at the moment.

Ethical Judgment and Empathy

The webtext says that Ethical judgment involves thoughtfully responding to situations instead reacting to them. The job requirements are the development of appropriate support for individuals based on their needs and to help them succeed in the social role identified. I believe you genuinely display empathy by engaging in person-centered support and services. Also, the webtext says that to be empathetic, you must consider what others are feeling and why-

especially when their emotions are not the same as what others are feeling ("What Is Emotional Intelligence?", 2020).
