In order to receive the first year \$2500 reward, please email the following IN PDF FORMAT, to me:

1. Your personal letter of acceptance of the Scholarship and description of how funds will be used.
The letter of acceptance must be received within one week of this notification.
2. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the four-year college you will attend.
3. The date of the month and year you will enter the four-year college. Recipient of The Finch College Alumni Foundation Scholarship may delay entrance to the four-year college a maximum of one year.
4. Your social security number.
5. A personal photo to be used for Finch College Foundation newsletters and publicizing the scholarship.
6. Your personal email address and your student mailing address at the four-year college.
7. Address to which the check should be mailed
8. A follow-up annual report evidencing that the Scholarship is being used for the purpose approved by The Board of Trustees and that you are a student in good standing.
