



Bogdan Tudor is founder and CEO of the most prominent IT support services company in Romania with operations in Europe and United States and also serves as an Associate Professor in the EMBA program at ASEBUSS Business School in partnership with Georgia State University, where he teaches the Digital Transformation course.
