Titus 3.10

Being divisive is a sin. We are called to keep the unity of the Spirit (Eph 4.3); divisions are sinful (I Cor 1). Paul teaches Titus this same principle. If you see someone who is dividing the body, then you are to warn him. Then, you should warn him a second time. After that final attempt to change their behavior, you can know, "that such people are warped and sinful."

Clearly the church is being taught to address sin. We are taught that we ALL have responsibilities to this end. What Paul does not want any church member to be "warped and sinful." That is why we must be learning what kind of lives are worthy of the calling we have received (Eph 4.1).

Today we are learning strictly from our Master's teachings about sin. Obeying Jesus' words will keep us from this place of being "warped and sinful," because we will realize what not to do.
