All day today we will keep our minds attentive to thoughts about <u>heaven</u>, the home of the righteous in Christ Jesus.

You must be **born of water and the Spirit** to enter the kingdom of God (<u>John 3.3-5</u>). You must be **clothed with Christ** (<u>Gal 3.26-27</u>). You must be **circumcised in Him**, with a circumcision not done by the hands of men (<u>Col 2.11-13</u>). Your **old self must be crucified with Him** (<u>Rm 6.6</u>).

All of these describe **baptism**, from different discussions. Jesus commanded it for anyone who wanted to become a disciple (Mt 28.18-20). Three thousand are commanded to repent, right before they are baptized into Christ (Acts 2.38). Only then will they receive forgiveness of sin (Acts 22.16) and the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2.38-39). Baptism is how we are born again, by water and the Spirit (Jn 3.5), and that is why Peter brings up Noah, so he can reference the ark. "In it only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water, and this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also" (I Pe 3.20-21). Do you see that people who have obeyed baptism because of their faith, repent because they know they have sinned, and they now realize that they must be saved (i.e., to have forgiveness of sins, to be circumcised with Him, to be clothed with Christ, to have the old self crucified). These all happen by faith in Jesus Christ, when you are baptized. The one who does this becomes a citizen of heaven, one who is saved by their obedient faith. This same one, now lives a life of faith to God's glory, and should never give up.
