In about one month Andra and I will be heading for **Brazil**. Jamie Richardson and his wife, Tammy, will be going with us. Jamie has more than 25 years of experience working in Brazil. He will also serve as translator, driver, and an educated person able to help us. He and I will both teach during the trip. We are paying for Jamie's travel costs since he is vital to our first trip. Additionally, it serves as a way for me to be able to make contacts in the southern part of Brazil, something the Barrier's have not had.

We will leave March 20. We will have Bible studies in the homes of church members almost nightly. We will need to take a domestic flight from Belo Horizonte to Ipatinga. We will be working with churches in both cities. We will encourage small groups of the Lord's people, by teaching them from the word of God. This will build them up in the faith, and hopefully motivate them to continue to share the saving power of the gospel. We are planning to meet with a new convert in a new town, so we are very excited about possibilities of seeing a new church there.

Andra will come home March 29. I will be flying to Recife on March 29, where I will work with Randy and Kathy Short. My schedule will look very similar to what we will do in Belo. Groups will be meeting nightly to study, and I will be teaching with Randy. Randy is not going to be able to travel with me to every one of the cities where I will be working, so he had arranged for Ricardo Sobral to be my translator. We will need to take 3 domestic flights to get our work completed, and we will be paying to assist Ricardo.

I will fly home Apr 6. Hopefully, I will be able to give a full report Apr 9, since Scott is covering for me when I am out on Apr 2.

We have sufficient funds for this trip. It is looking like this trip will cost around \$3500, per person. If you want to help with this work, then you can get your money to me, or earmark checks South America mission. We have 2 more trips planned this year (May-June and Sept-Oct). And please join us in prayer for the work we will be doing all over SA this year!
