Israel was divided **from** groups of people:

1. From Egypt (**Exodus**). They had to come out of Egypt. They had to leave the Egyptian gods behind. They had to forsake their ways.
2. From the Canaanites (**Joshua**). They had to destroy the nations who were living in the land of promise. The only way God's people could have what God promised was for them to totally destroy these groups, and by doing that, you could say they were divided from those 7 nations that were conquered in the book of Joshua.
3. This is why the term Jews and Gentile have the meaning we know. Jews were those under the law, in covenant relation with God. The Gentiles were not. The Jews were the children of promise, and the Gentiles were not. This was a division everybody understood. You can see Paul's discussion in **Galatians**.

God is WAY more comfortable with the place of division than we are. He knows that such divisions exist today, just like He was able to recognize divisions in times of history. Jesus learns the relevance of division from His Father. Jesus is just like His Father when it comes to this teaching about division. He sought to teach His disciples. That is why we are listening to Him this morning.
