This morning we will go back to our thoughts from Luke 12.49-53 from a couple weeks ago. What we want to do this morning is to look at two similar examples.

We are going to examine Ps 101 entirely and exclusively. As we study and learn we will be carried to greater understanding. We will take what we learn and find another picture of what we are seeing this morning. There is a reason for doing this.

We learn by repetition. It is essential to learn a principle from Luke 12.49-53. One way to do that is to see that particular principle in the form of a Psalms. And then we can think more clearly about what each one of us should be doing with Luke 12. We will all have a clearer idea of what Jesus meant in Luke 12 by considering this Psalm.

This afternoon we will conclude with a passage from Jesus's teaching that will help bring the principle of Luke 12 into something we can easily practice. Let's grow together in the Lord today.
