What happens when someone corrects you? How do you react when someone stops you in the middle of your speech and says that the word you are using is incorrect? For someone who talks for a living, I strive to craft words in such a way that will garner attention, keep attention, and leave a mark on those that hear them. Therefore, if someone were to interrupt me and say that I was using a word incorrectly, I would instantly be defensive and demand proof.

This is the human condition: correction = defensive response. Our initial reaction to those who attempt to rearrange our viewpoint or our usage of certain terms is to push back against the correction. This can blind us from actually considering whether or not the correction comes from a valid place. We can also be blinded from recognizing the care of the person who is attempting to correct us. This leads us to a place of steadfastness where there should be flexibility. As we study today, we will examine the concept of 'redefinition' and how to redirect our spiritual vision to fit more closely to those that followed Jesus in the first century.
