

2025 Romeo Peach Festival Bed Races

The Bed Races are coming back to the Romeo Peach Festival after an almost 10 year hiatus! There is room for a few more teams. Neighboring high schools, police departments and fire departments have been invited and may make up some of the teams. Each team will be comprised of four pushers and one rider. The competition will involve pushing a twin-sized bed (or larger) and rider 60 yards; participating in a brief (5-10 second) team activity; and pushing the bed and rider the final 60 yards. The top three (based on entries) times will win a cash prize. Beds will be available for teams to use but team-produced beds can also be brought to the event.

Prior to the race – the team costumes will be evaluated by a few judges. Be creative but make sure that you can run in them. The top three (based on entries) will win a cash prize. You can be part of history as we bring this fun competition back to the festival. This could be an entertaining talking point at your organization and will certainly bring out the competitiveness in you and foster some camaraderie between you and your competitors...as having fun is the primary focus.

The bed race will take place on Sunday, August 31st (day before Labor Day) approximately 6:30pm. This time may be adjusted slightly based on scheduling of festival events. The race will occur on Main Street – just south of 32 Mile Road. The team fee will be \$25 per team. All collected money will go toward the prize money awarded to the top team costumes and top race times.
