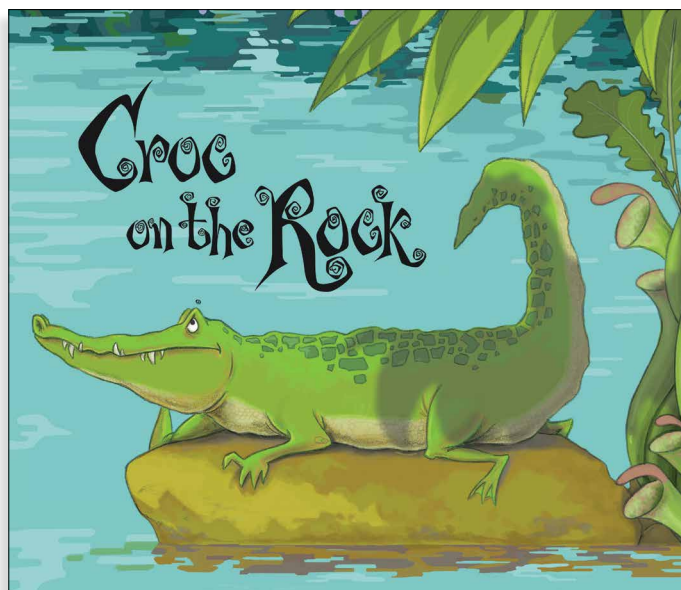
ABOUT THE AUTHOR AND ILLUSTRATOR
