



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- 1. Clean the surface of the UTV that the windshield will be applied to.
- 2. Remove the protective cover from the windshield.
- 3. To make the installation of the seals easier, run a 1/4" extension along the center of the seals. See Photo 1.
- 4. Install the seal with the bulb along the bottom of the windshield and the thin seal around the top and sides. Trim any excess of the seal. **See Photo 2**.







- 5. Peel the adhesive backer off the rubber pads and attach them to the three top brackets as shown in Photo 3.
- 6. **NOTE:** The side where the Rough Country logo can be seen will be referred to as the "front". Install the stiffening brace on the front side of the windshield using the supplied 1/4" x 1 1/2" button head bolts, 1/4" washers, and 1/4" lock nuts. Tighten with a 5/32" Allen wrench and 7/16" wrench. **See Photo 4.**






- 7. Flip the windshield over and install the top brackets with rubber pads onto the protruding stud of the button head bolt. Thread the 1/4" knob onto the threading. **See Photo 5.**
- 8. Install the four bottom brackets on the back side of the windshield as shown in **Photo 6.** Tighten with a 5/32" Allen wrench and 7/16" wrench.





- 9. With assistance, lift the rear windshield and hook the bottom brackets over the metal plate as shown in **Photo 7.**
- 10. Rotate the top brackets as shown in **Photo 10** and tighten the knob to secure the rear windshield in place.
