## 5 SCHEDULE

---

5.1.1 The technical meeting on **16 September** 2020 will be held at **0900** local time via videoconferencing using Cisco Webex at <https://herr-xoz.my.webex.com/meet/kiteclasses>.

## 6 FORMAT AND SCORING

---

6.2 The format will be an Opening Stage, followed by a Podium Stage for the top 14 teams and a Final Race for the remaining teams.

6.3.3 Final Series

- a) 4 races are required to be completed by the gold and silver flights to constitute a Final Series.
- b) Teams will be assigned to Final Series flights gold, silver, bronze etc., based on their ranking in the Qualifying Series. Flights gold and silver will have **6 teams**, all other flights will have, as nearly as possible, equal size. Teams with the best Qualifying Series ranks will race all Final Series races in flight gold, kiteboards with the next-best Qualifying Stage ranking will race in flight silver, etc.
- c) Any recalculation of Qualifying Series rankings after teams have been assigned to Final Series flights will not affect the assignments except that a redress decision may promote a team to a higher flight.
- d) A team's Carry Forward score is equal to her ranking position in the Qualifying Series.

NoR/SI 6.5.3 is deleted

6.5.4 Teams not qualified to the Podium Stage will sail a Final Race.

- a) They will be ranked from place 15 and on, according to their Opening Stage score plus their Final Race score, which may be one of the excluded scores. This changes RRS A2.
- b) Teams competing in flight bronze will be ranked in front of teams competing in subsequent flights etc. This may not apply to a team disqualified under RRS 5, 6 or 69.

# 17 PROTESTS, PENALTIES AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

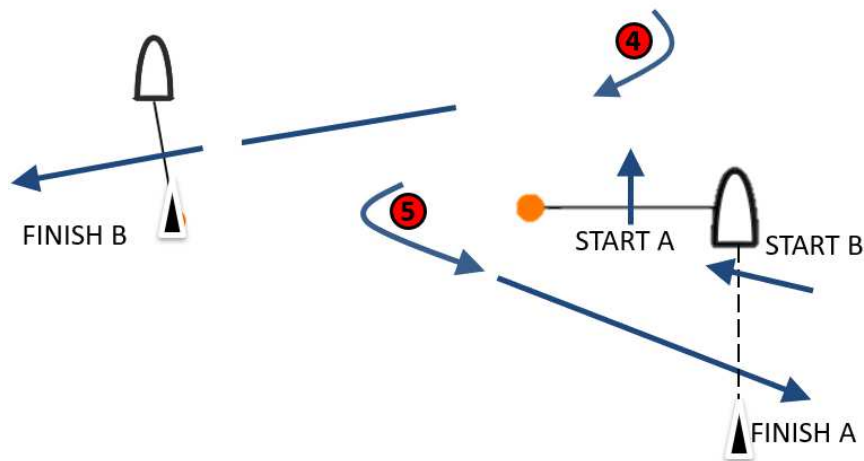
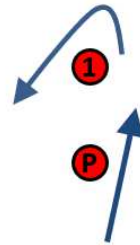

- 17.2 Notices will be posted within 15 minutes of the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held beginning at the time posted. Hearings may be scheduled to begin before the end of the protest time limit.

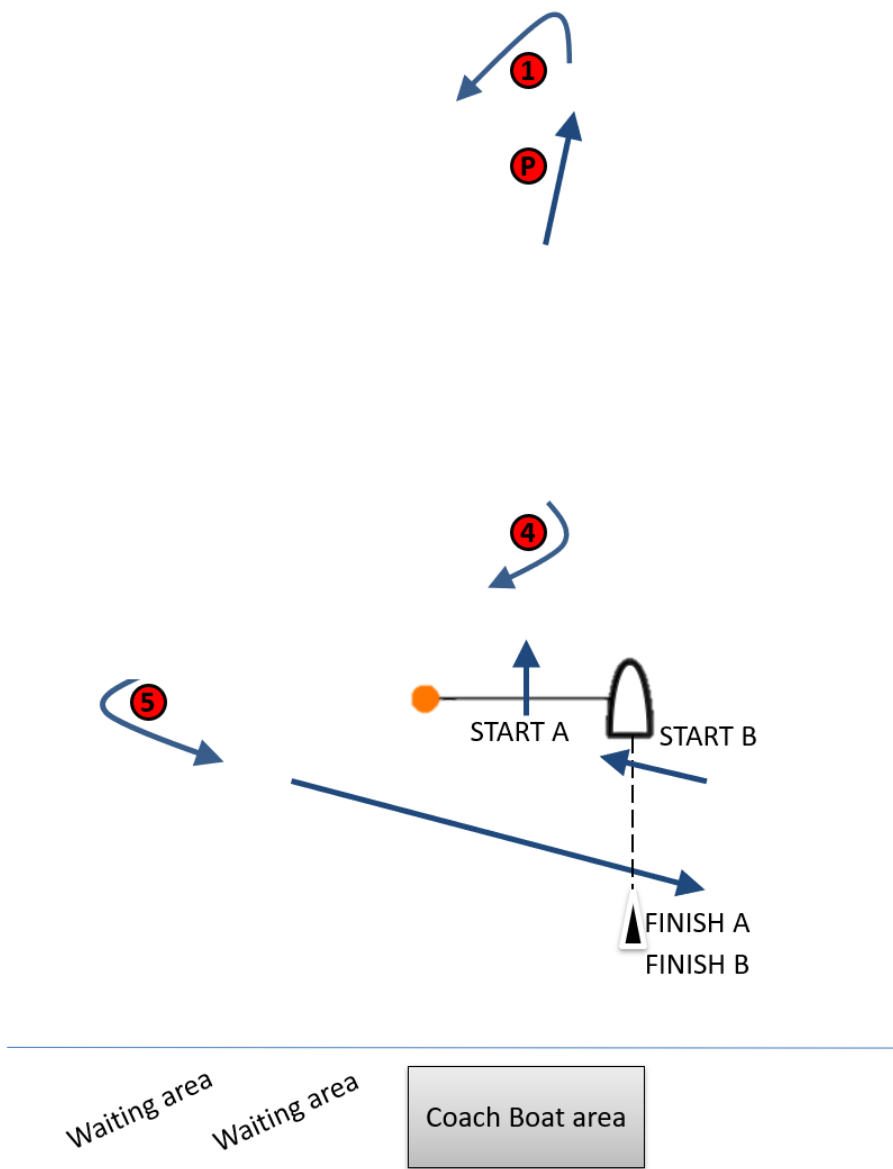
Waiting area

Coach Boat area

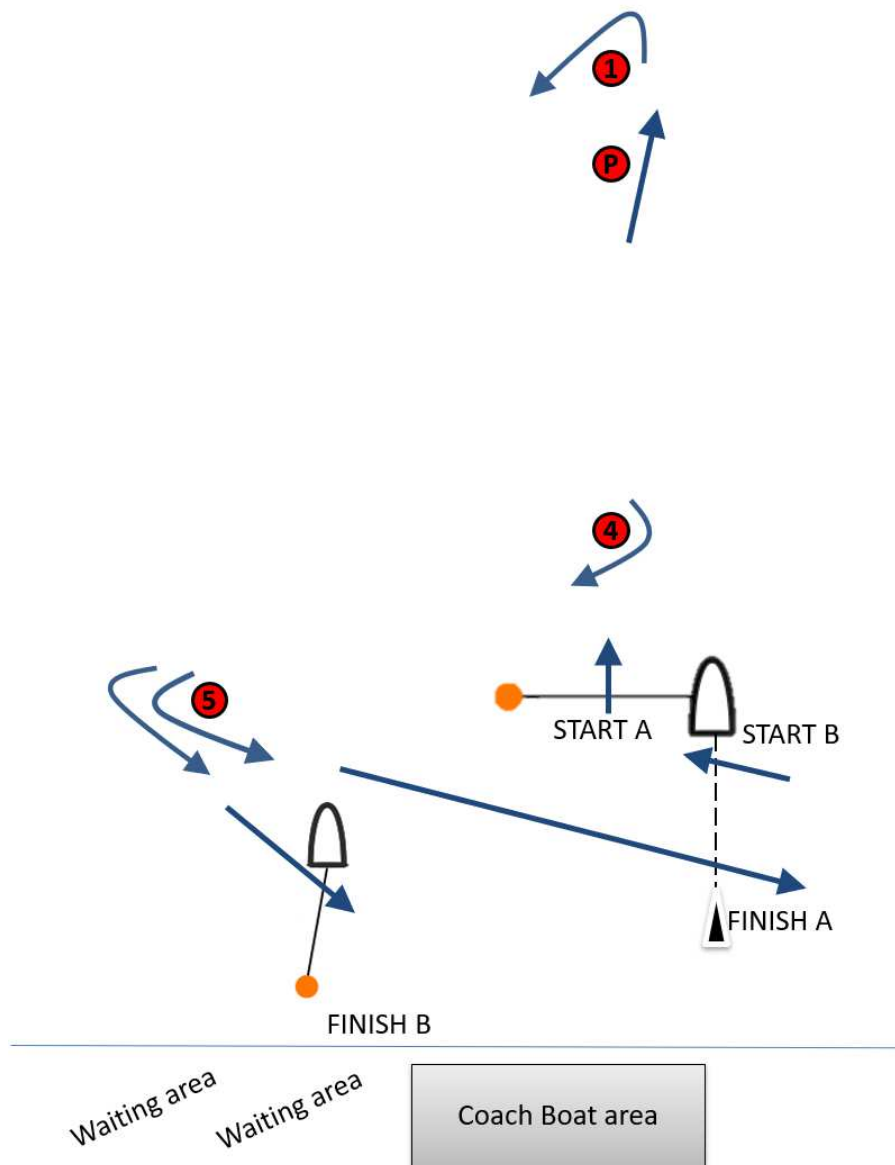
**XR: Start A – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – 5p – Finish A – Start B – Pp – 1p – Pp – 4s – Finish B**
