7. DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT (use another sheet if necessary)

With fewer than 45 seconds to the start we were luffing about 5-6 boat lengths to the left and 3-4 boat lengths under the line of the RC boat USA 43 came full speed behind our stern and immediately heeded us up past ~~the~~ ^{head to wind} with ^{inadequate} opportunity to keep clear. Our jib ^{became} backwinded and we were attempting to keep clear of 2 boat to windward of us. USA 43 would not stop heading past ~~the~~ ^{head to wind} and hit us even though she had ample room to keep clear.
