J/70 Class Rule C.5.2.b.8 admit *"Small clips or keepers to retain running rigging in place when it is not being used."*

To understand if a cam-cleat is allowed and considered a keeper or a retainer, a question has been asked to the J/70 Tech. Committee Mr. Polk Wagner.

Here the question followed by the official answer:

Q: "By Class Rule C.5.2.b.8 *"Small clips or keepers to retain running rigging in place when it is not being used."*

My question is if a cam cleat positioned on the compass bracket can be considered a "keeper" and therefore allowed.

Thank you for your answer."

A: No, we do not allow extra cleats. They can use Soak clips and other things like that for that purpose but not a cam cleat.

Warning: all boats using a cam-cleat on the mast as retainer/keeper must take off it before the 1st race.
