**Question:**

**Is there any limit to the number of crew that may race on a TP52?**

**Answer:**

**No, there is no limit. However, all crew shall be registered, crew fees paid [NoR 14] and shall be on board for all races, unless given written permission otherwise by the Race Committee [NoR 6.1(b)]**

**Reasoning:**

1. TP52 is not a one-design class and the Kings Cup 2019 is not a TP52 class event. TP52 only compete in the event under IRC.
2. RRS 78.1 requires all boats to comply with their rating certificate. However, NoR 6.1.(a) makes IRC 22.4 [Crew Number/Weight] inapplicable as permitted by IRC 22.4.3.
3. NoR 6.1(b) requires the crew to remain the same and to be on board for all races, unless replacement is approved by the Race Committee.
