Publishing date	Article Deadline	The primary emphasis for each edition.
August 1	July 15	Pre-season announcements for leagues, tournaments & Nationals.
November 1	October 15	Articles & Updates submitted by Leagues, Tournaments & Teams.
February 1	January 15	Pre-Nationals edition. As well as any Notices about the Spring Season. Also including more Articles, Standings and Updates submitted by Leagues, Tournaments & Teams.
May 1	April 15	Season's wrap-up, plus discussions and plans for the next season.

For those wishing to form a new AAU League and/or a new AAU League

This is far easier than some individuals may imagine. And the process is very similar whether you are forming a league or tournament.

For new AAU leagues it mostly comes down to having enough teams interested within a reasonable commuting range. Actually forming an AAU Club and getting an AAU league license is very easy and fairly inexpensive.

- First an adult must become an AAU member. A non-athlete adult membership for a youth program costs \$16 per season.
- Then you form your (Level 2 or 3) AAU Club. An AAU Level 2 Club membership costs \$60 per season.
- Then obtain an AAU license.

⇒ **AAU League license** generally costs \$350 for the season. Please note that AAU generally charges \$50 per day except that charges are capped at 7 days, even though a league season may run 365 days.

⇒ **AAU League licenses** cost \$50 per day (for example a 3-day tournament is \$100, a 3-day is \$150 and a 4-day is \$200. Regardless how many teams participate). However, please be aware that hosting multiple tournaments does require separate AAU League license for each.

Existing AAU Tournament Operators We essentially have the same concerns for AAU Tournaments as with our AAU leagues. We will be creating an **AAU Ice Hockey - Tournament Guide**. Please provide your Tournament details and please stick to our format including all of the following:

- ⇒ Name of the tournament (such as: **AAU Grinder Gobbler Hockey Tournament**)
- ⇒ Starting Date (such as: **Nov 23, 2018**)
- ⇒ Ending Date (such as: **Nov 25, 2018**)
- ⇒ Location City & State (such as: **St.Clair Shores, MI**)
- ⇒ Cost (such as: **\$1095**)
- ⇒ Age Classification (please do not use terms like Mites or Squirts. Please use **7U, 8U, 9U, 10U ...**)
- ⇒ Competition level (Please be honest. Such as **House**, and/or **Travel A-AA** and/or **Travel AAA**)
- ⇒ Website (such as: **www.grinderhockey.com**)
- ⇒ Phone (such as: **321 794-0222**)
- ⇒ Minimum # of games (such as: **4 minimum**)
- ⇒ Periods (such as: **12x12x15** or **3*13min**)

The AAU Ice Hockey newsletter attempts to give teams the needed information within an easily understood standardize format. Please note: Tournaments failing to provide all information will be excluded.
