# *National Programme Previews*

## **Under 16 - European Championships**

On July 25th, the U16 Irish National Team will fly to Spain to compete for the first time in the World Skate European Championships.

It will more precisely be in the charming city of Valladolid.

Bringing a team together throughout the season was a tough process, to say the least, but with effort, dedication, and consistency we have managed to create a group that will consist of 3 lines and 3 goalkeepers. We have also managed to expand our U16 National Development squad with 3 recent additions in order to prepare for the future, and are still in the process of trying to find more players born from 2010 to 2008.

The group has trained really hard and has displayed an exemplary commitment to the Irish jersey thus far. Indeed, they have already completed three 2-day camps, 2-short practices after U15 league game days, 3 friendly preparation games, and countless Zoom theory sessions. All of which have a high attendance rate which speaks volumes in terms of those young players' dedication.

Knowing we will be facing some of the best teams in Europe, we remain pragmatic in terms of our expectations but are confident in the resourcefulness, and work ethic of those young players.

Therefore, we have asked ourselves, how should we define success for this U16 National Team this season? If those U16 players learn how to prepare properly for international events, and if they learn how to build chemistry, and the way the game is played by Irish national teams at this age, it will be a success and time saver for future seasons.

If they are able to properly consolidate all their individual skills fundamentals and more at this age, it will be valuable for future seasons.

If the group is capable of having a homogeneous number of players spread out over different birth years, it will be valuable for future Irish National Teams in the above age groups. If they learn the value and privilege of playing for the Irish jersey and the responsibilities that come with it this young, they will hopefully one day inspire others younger than them.

And, no matter what the results may be, we can already be satisfied with what that group of young players has already achieved, and everyone on this island can be proud of them. We hope this National Team will do well and we count on all of you to be behind us in spirit!

After two years absence, we are all excited about returning to international competition and the World Skate Games in Buenos Aires.

One of our major goals was to create a development pathway, and to see people coming through the ranks and increasing the level of competition across the board is hugely encouraging.

Thankfully though, not everything is new. Most of the team have played at the senior level previously and have experience from both Asiago in 2018 and Barcelona in 2019. However, what is realistic is improving on our world ranking and checking off another one of our development goals.

The returning players now have a much better understanding of what to expect and what we need to do to have success. Between now and October we have the opportunity to build some chemistry and improve as a group, hopefully translating to wins when we are in Argentina.

For us in Ireland, the opportunity to play in South America isn't something that many of us will get. It is important that we grab this chance with both hands and give a good account of ourselves. It is always great to know that we have the support of people back home, and we look forward to representing you all in October.

## *Senior Women - World Skate Games*

This October, the Senior Women's National Team will fly to Buenos Aires, Argentina to compete in their first National Competition with World Skate, the World Roller Games.

We hosted trials for the senior women's squad back in January which received a well rounded turnout of players. Moving forward from the trials the team hit a difficult spot due to player injuries and other unseen circumstances. After making some alterations the team rallied back and brought each other together again and have recently been producing some really strong hockey. After the team was brought back together there are currently 11 skaters and 2 goalkeepers selected to represent the team in Argentina. We are looking to add 1 more skater to the team to round the team out to 3 lines and 2 goalkeepers.

The whole squad has put in an incredible amount of effort and commitment within training, and have shown that each and every one of them deserve the Irish colours upon their chests (development players included). Since January the squad has undergone a lot of preparation for the World Championships completing 5 training sessions where they were pushed to the limit of every minute.

Not knowing exactly who our competition is going to be in Argentina, the team is pushing more and more each week to be prepared for any opponent which they face. This being the team's first year in a national competition we are remaining pessimistic of our expectations of where we will finish in the Championships but still carrying high hopes that the team will go far into the tournament.

There is no doubt in the eyes of the coaching staff for the team that they are ready to go away to Argentina and wreak havoc on whatever opposition they face. With the preparations past and more to come the team will be ready to produce some satisfying hockey and play the game the right way at the biggest stage.

No matter what results the team produces, we can look back and see the program as a success bringing in more talented female players into the sport.

We are sure the team will make us all proud and we can count on everyone at home to be pressing us on from home or wherever you may be.

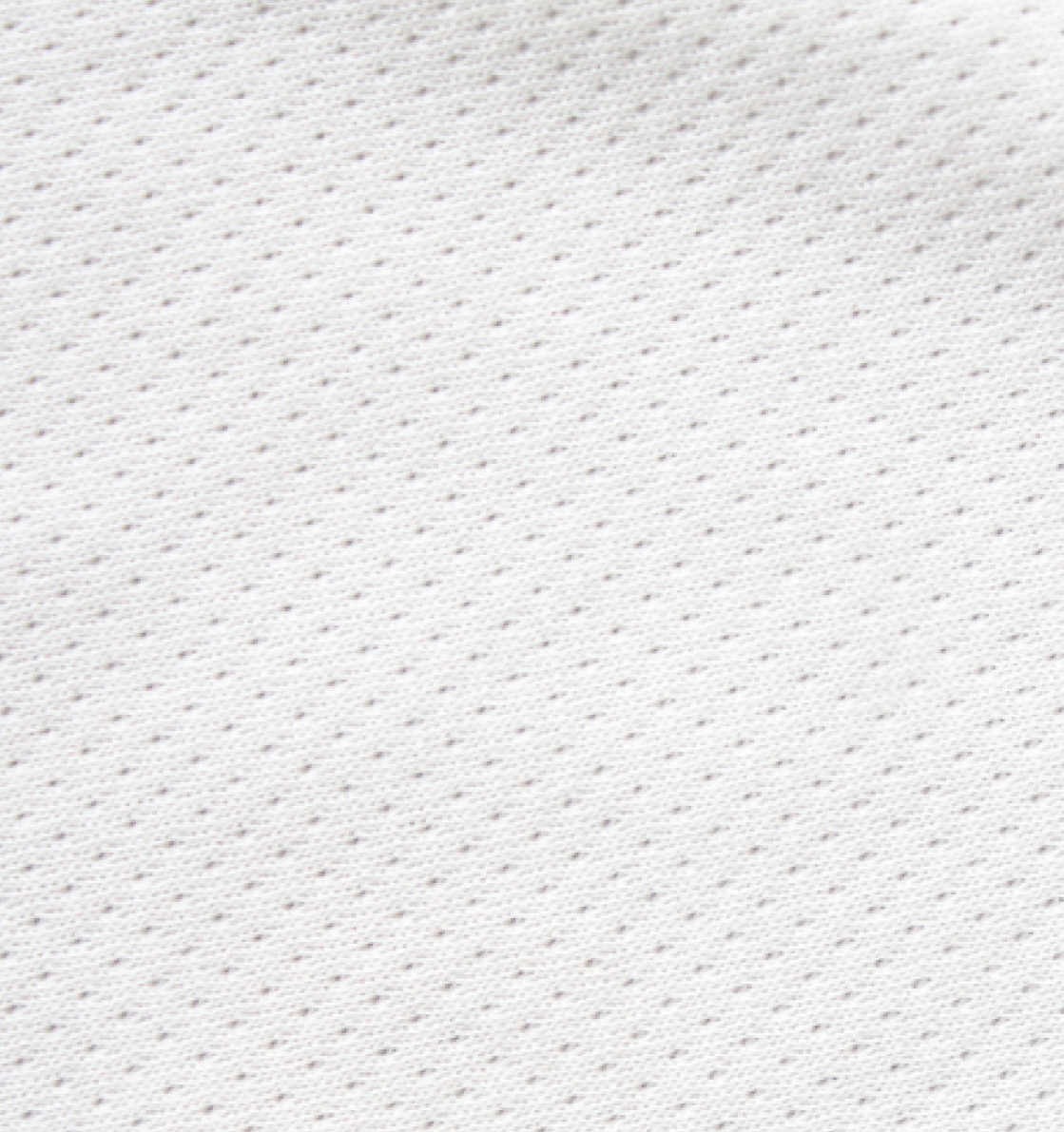
