







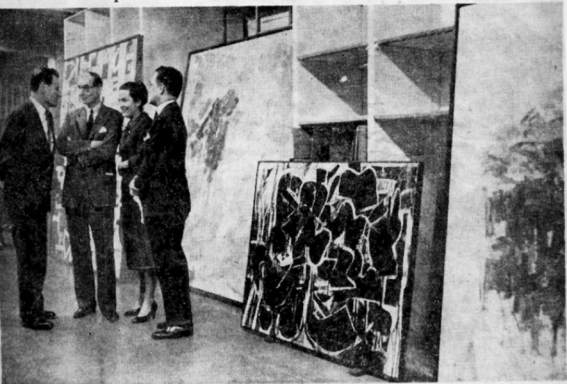








New World Prepares to Show Its Cultural Achievements to Old World

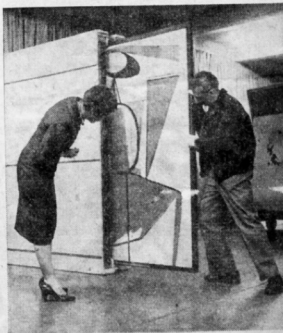

Alfred H. Barr, director of museum collections; Miss Dorothy C. Miller, curator of museum collections, and Porter McCray, head of museum's international program.

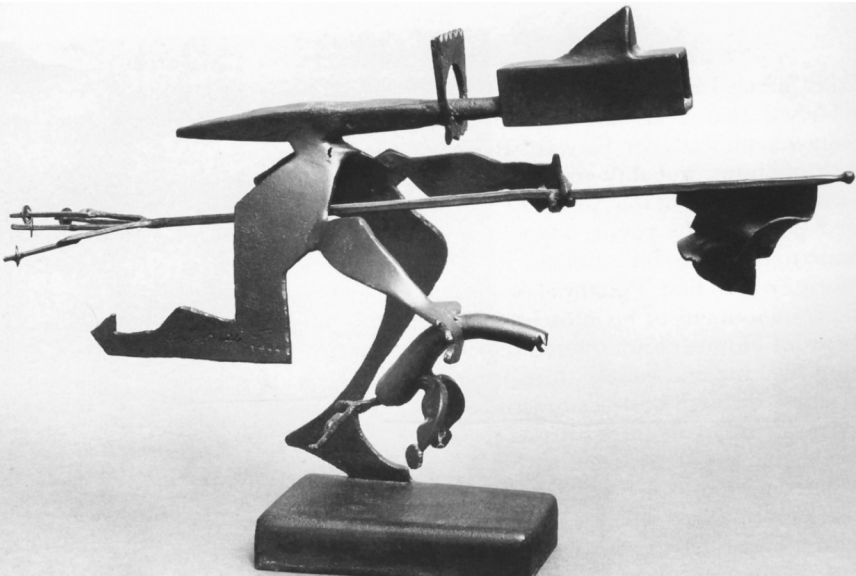


Miss Virginia Pearson, museum's Circulation Director, supervises work of craftsmen who are building a frame.



Miss Miller follows the packing of one of the pictures in a special crate. She chose the pictures for the tour.

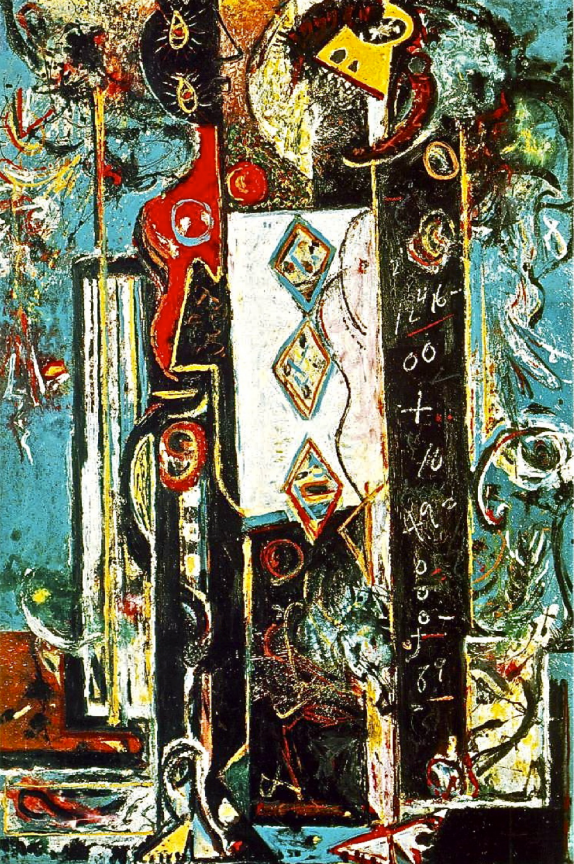

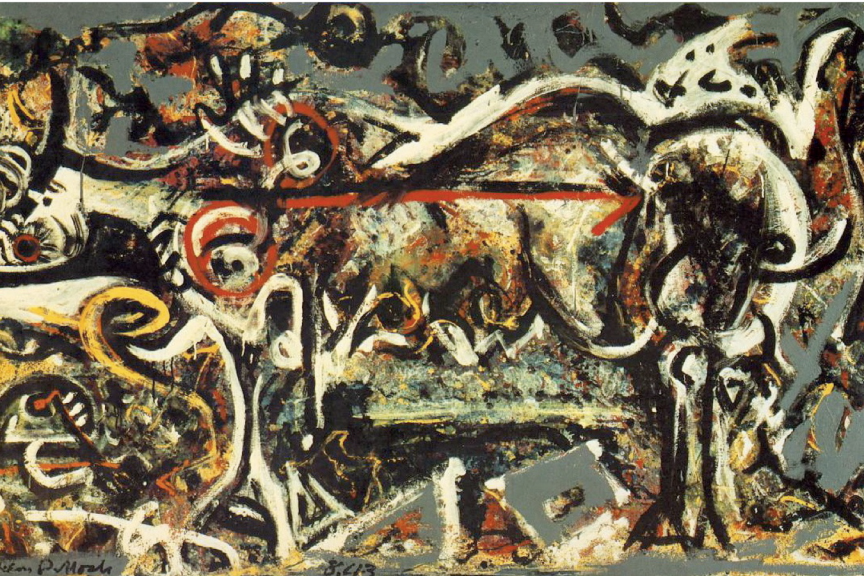
