## TERMS

**PREPAID ORDERS:** This is the very best method. Your personal check or any other form of payment is satisfactory, but be sure to include an amount for **CARRYING CHARGES** otherwise we may have to return your order for an additional amount. Prepaid orders will not be entered if remittance does not cover all charges.

**BILLED:** If you **HAVE** established an open account with us, terms are 30 days net. No discount for cash in advance.

If you wish to establish an account, send four references and **ALLOW** time for us to receive replies, usually 2 weeks.

Please do not give bank references.

**C. O. D.** C. O. D. shipments will be made only on orders of \$20.00 or more value. An added charge of \$1.00 is made on each shipment. **EVERY** request for a C. O. D. shipment must be **PARTLY** paid in **ADVANCE**. Minimum \$5.00 advance. If a C. O. D. package is refused a service charge will be made.

## SHIPMENTS

**"U.S. Parcel Post" or "United Parcel Service"**

**UNITED PARCEL SERVICE** is the **FASTEST** way to have things delivered. **WE FAVOR** this because of the **SPEED** and **CARE** with which packages are handled. Our charge for this service is the same as **PARCEL POST** and **INSURANCE**. Area served changes—Yours may be included now.

Town residents use street number, rural residents use road name, and how to locate house. **THEY WILL NOT LEAVE PACKAGES UNLESS SIGNED FOR.** Expect deliveries during normal business hours. Deliveries will be attempted on three consecutive days; if not possible then, packages will be returned to us. We will then reship by Parcel Post at your added expense.

**PREFERENCE OF METHOD:** If you can make use of it, you may specify U. P. S. on each order, or for all orders. If you do not state how shipments are to be made, we will use our best judgment.

## MINIMUM SHIPMENTS

No order for less than \$3.00 can be accepted for shipment. If you have an open account and order items totaling less than this, we will add a service charge to bring the total to \$3.00.

Our "Golden Glow" Brass Polish is shipped in minimum lots of four one pint cans for \$5.00, which includes postage, add \$1.00 west of the Mississippi.

Advance paid or C. O. D. Orders for less than minimum amounts must be returned to you with questions.

## STANDARD FINISHES

**ANTIQUE:** This resembles the color of fine originals and is accomplished through a special process that oxidizes the surface of the brass, no lacquer is used or required. This color will improve with age.

**POLISHED BRIGHT:** This is known as our "GOLDEN GLOW" finish. This is a high lustre, perfectly smooth surface resembling hand polished old brass. This finish will tarnish if not repolished from time to time as in normal household cleaning.

**THERE IS NO DIFFERENCE IN COST** for either the **ANTIQUE** or "GOLDEN GLOW" finish on **REGULAR BRASS CABINET HARDWARE**—pages 2 to 20.

All wood screws furnished with antique hardware are finished to match. Screws furnished with polished hardware are commercial, not fully polished. Add minimum \$.50 to each order for full polish. Full polish screws are furnished at no extra charge on brass X series locks, W series lights, R series jamb hooks and a few other items.

For finishes on **IRON** items see notes under each in price list.

**REFUND:** Refund will be made at time of shipment for overpayment of postage or insurance so remit an ample amount.

**ADVANCE PAID,** shipment will be insured only if you include an amount sufficient to cover both **POSTAGE** and **INSURANCE**.

## HOW TO ORDER - Continued

Some items are offered in more than one finish.

When a preference is not stated with EACH order, we will use our own judgment. An order returned for change of color is subject to a minimum \$2.00 charge and upward depending on our costs.

### STANDARD FINISHES — PAGES 20 TO END

All brass items are furnished in "GOLDEN GLOW" polish finish with these exceptions. Lacquered finishes on all items on page 47, all pins pages 50 & 51 and bell pull fittings page 52, catalog number, H-A-101.

IRON ITEMS, Flat black paint on all builders hardware, series X, pages 20 to 32 and hook R-500 on page 46.

Hand forged hook R-501, as forged, R-600 hand polished after forging.

### LACQUER FINISH

This is standard on all items on page 47, all pins pages 50 and 51 and bell pull fittings page 52 catalog number H-A-101.

We do not recommend lacquer on any other items. We will quote prices on lacquer finish on request. Give full listing of items. Minimum on each order \$1.00. 10% to 20% extra will usually cover.

If it is not listed in a catalog price listing, it is a SPECIAL ITEM.

Requests for SPECIAL ITEMS or catalog items in SPECIAL SIZES, ETC., must first be given careful attention. Usually it is necessary to consider making a special run at some additional cost. After the facts are found a quotation must be made. This means a letter. Avoid these delays if at all possible by making selection from catalog.

When ordering stock items and also when asking about non-catalog items, time will be saved if you put request on separate letters.

"THINCAST" wherever used by us signifies the very finest quality cast plates with our best workmanship.

### ABOUT RETURNING MATERIALS

Catalogs are published with complete details so you will know the item BEFORE you order. We stand back of our quality and our mistakes, but if we are not at fault and you decide to return any items a charge must sometimes be made.

Please ask for permission before returning any item.

**HANDLING CHARGE:** must usually be made, the amount depends on all circumstances. Items made to order are not usually returnable.

We charge for boxing or crating a very few items. You will be given the details if such a charge is necessary.

Some items are not interchangeable and must be ordered for right or left hand.

### TO TELL THE HAND OF DOORS

To tell the hand of a door, stand with your back against it so that it can not open— if the hinges are on your left, it is a left hand door. This method can be used for any doors, house, cupboard or furniture.

## Information Series "D" and "E"

All "D" Series pulls are stamped in hardened steel dies, exact copies of originals. All posts have turned heads and round nuts. All bails are cast and fine hand workmanship is at once apparent throughout. These, like all other brasses by Ball and Ball, are in stock in our famous GOLDEN GLOW polished finish or ANTIQUE color. Escutcheons for "D" Series pulls were never made to match, the most used ones are L-65 and L-64. Use L-66 on cut corner D-39 or D-44 pulls, other escutcheons of bone or ivory like L-68 were used especially on inlaid furniture.

Escutcheons for use with "D" Pulls are listed under "L" Series.

Above numbers E-46 to E-51 are for French furniture, Number E-49 is furnished in right and left (illustration is right-hand).

E Series pulls date from 1740 to 1850. Generally speaking, the plain ones as E-25, E-29, E-31, etc. are Chippendale types, the rope edge ones like E-27 and E-32 are Hepplewhite and Sheraton but there are many exceptions. E-39 type was used on some very fine furniture of 1745-1765 period. E-40 and E-56 are Queen Anne types, E-44 and E-53 are Directoire and the E-46 to E-51 types were used on French furniture over a long period of time.

Escutcheons for rosette pulls were usually made to match the design and shape of rosettes though some were alike only in details of design, example—pull E-43 was used with esc. L-88.
