
Keyless Handle Instructions


The enclosed Keyless Handle has been created as a permanent tool to allow access to the inside of the cabinet without the need for a waffle key.

WARNING: Do not put the Keyless Handle together until reading all the instructions below. Once the key is assembled, it can not be disassembled without breaking it.

Step 1 – The Keyless Handle is comprised of 2 pieces: the Teeth and the Handle (see illustration below). The back side of the key is noted by two arrows that line up. The backside of the key will face the wall when it has been properly assembled onto the cover of the unit and the unit is closed.



Step 2 – Open the cover of the dispenser with the temporary "waffle" key that was included with the dispenser. From the inside of the cover, align the teeth side of the Keyless Handle to the matching opening in the top of the cover and insert through cover in the direction of the "arrow".



Step 3 –Now that the teeth of the key are through the cover of the dispenser, align the Handle of the key such that the arrows face the same direction and point toward each other as shown. Slide the Handle down until a positive "click" is felt and the components will not separate. If you do not feel or hear the "click", check to make sure the arrows are properly oriented to each other per the illustration and reassemble. Take the teeth side of the key out of the dispenser and turn it around and reinsert it through the cover. Attach the two pieces together until you hear a click.

Step 4 – Once you have correctly installed the Keyless Handle you will no longer need the "waffle" key included with the unit. Your key is now installed and will now serve as your permanent method of opening your dispenser. Apply the "HOW TO INSTALL KEY" sticker inside the back of the dispenser. Simply pull the handle of the key towards you to open the dispenser.
