

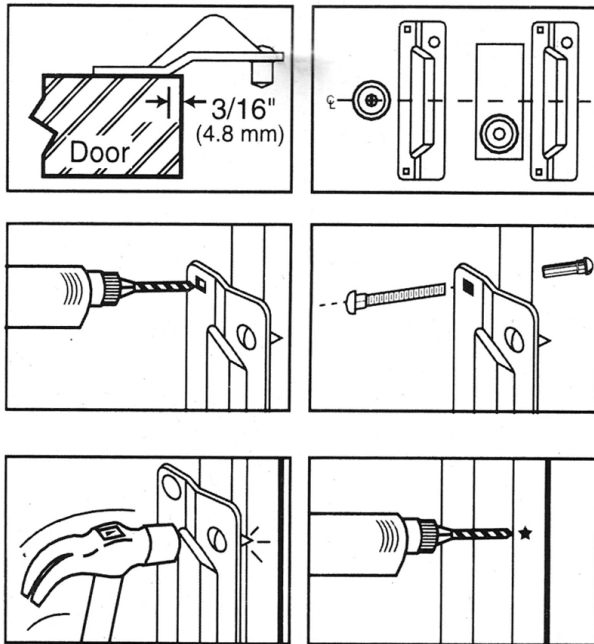

Latch Protection Plate

340D - US32
SATIN STAINLESS STEEL

Installation Instructions

The six simple steps to install this product require a drill, 5/16" (7.9 mm) drill bit, hammer, and wrench.



- Step # 1. Place the flat surface of the Hager Latch Protection Plate 3/16" (4.8 mm) in from the edge of the door.
- Step # 2. Center the plate vertically on the center of the lock, whether mortised or cylindrical.
- Step # 3. With the square hole held to the door, use this as a guide to drill two 5/16" (7.9 mm) diameter holes through the door.
- Step # 4. Insert two carriage bolts through the plate and secure with the 3/4" hex sleeve nuts on the inside.
- Step # 5. Close door until the pin makes contact with door jamb. Lightly strike head of pin with hammer to mark location of pin clearance hole.
- Step # 6. With the door in the open position, drill 5/6" (7.9 mm) diameter hole into the jamb, marked in step # 5.

Limited One Year Warranty

The only liability of the Company hereunder in tort or contract, under this warranty or otherwise shall be limited to the repair or replacement of any product or component part which shall prove defective to the original purchaser from the Company. The Company will not pay for the costs or repair performed other than in accordance with this warranty.

Written notice of a product believed to be defective as covered by this warranty should be sent to Hager Companies, 139 Victor Street, P.O. Box 12300, St. Louis, Missouri 63157-0300, and should include the purchaser's name and address, identification of the product, and brief description of the defect. Upon receipt of such notice, the Company will inform the purchaser where to ship such product, shipping charges prepaid, for examination. In the event such examination reveals a defect covered by this warranty, the Company will, at its own option, repair or replace the product, and return it or the replacement to the purchaser, with charge only for transportation.
